

Abbott House Scholarships for Success



The Abbott House Scholarship fund was created by people who believe in “giving a leg up” to those who need it. The scholarship funds are available through the Mary E. Fuchs Scholarship and the Abbott House Scholarship. These scholarships are used to help Abbott House and Bridges alums pursue their dreams of improving their lives. Scholarship money can be used for a variety of things including certification programs, technical school, post-secondary education and various other training opportunities that will support young adults as they face life’s challenges. Scholarship requirements are outlined below:

Application procedure

1. Applicants must complete application and cover letter requesting consideration for scholarship funds.
2. Scholarship applications can be submitted throughout the year to the Development Coordinator.
3. Scholarship application deadline is July 15.
4. Abbott House Scholarship Committee will review applications and determine the number of scholarships and scholarship value.
5. Recipients will be announced annually by August 1.
6. Scholarship monies will be mailed/transferred directly to educational institution/certificate or training program.
7. Recipients must submit course schedule and course unofficial transcript showing passing grades to receive the scholarship.
8. When success is demonstrated, applicants will only need to submit a letter or e-mail requesting to reapply for additional funding.
9. Applicants can reapply for as many years as they choose to continue their education. There is no limit to the number of scholarships an applicant can receive.
