

It has been such an exciting time to be part of the Abbott House. In the past year, we have continued to add to our clinical and therapeutic programming for youth. This has resulted in THE lowest 3 month period of critical incidents we have had in the past 15 years!!

We have also embarked on another expansion of our Bridges foster home program. As I write this, we are just a couple months away from opening two more beautiful homes in Sioux Falls. One of these homes will be for boys and the other for girls. I am so proud that we will soon offer 12 more young people in South Dakota a home, a family, and a new lease on life!!

At Abbott House we do foster care differently. The Agency buys or builds large, beautiful homes. Then we add vehicles and a full budget that covers all ongoing costs. Lastly, we hire a loving couple to move into one of our homes and become mom and dad for children in need. It is one of the most satisfying things I have ever been involved with.

Currently, we are looking for the couples we need to fill these homes. Now, maybe you are interested? If so, go to abbotthouse.org and fill out an application. 

85 Years Strong

Abbott House first opened in 1939 as a safe place for orphaned children. It was named after Grace Abbott, an outspoken advocate for children in the early 1900s. Grace Abbott helped shape the original Child Labor Laws and the landmark Social Security Act which became law in 1935. She died in 1939 before ever seeing the agency that bears her name.

Since opening, Abbott House has served thousands of children from across the state first as an orphanage and safe haven for boys and girls, then as a group care facility, next as a treatment program for adolescent South Dakota girls, and finally, in the 1990s, as a psychiatric

Abbott House Expands Foster Care Program in Sioux Falls



With more than 1,647 South Dakota children currently in foster care, there are still children waiting for foster families. In May 2023, the South Dakota Department of Social Services asked Abbott House leadership to consider expanding its therapeutic foster home program to the Sioux Falls area. The Abbott House Board of Directors approved the program expansion project and a \$2 million capital campaign was kicked off in November 2023. At the time of printing, Abbott House needs to raise \$111,151 to complete the campaign.

Using capital campaign funds, we have acquired two existing 6 - 7 bedroom homes and are remodeling them to fit our needs. Abbott House **does foster care differently**. We hire a married couple to live in each foster home and provide a family for up to six foster children. In addition to parents, Abbott House provides additional therapy, support, and other services to the youth in our foster homes, along with a salary and benefits, emotional support, and monthly respite time for the married couple.

Abbott House Opening WellHouse Pizza Truck Partnership

The WellHouse Pizza truck, an idea originally born from Abbott House to help youth learn workforce skills, will hit the road soon. Thanks to a wonderful partnership with WellFully and Fork Real, both of Rapid City, this unique program will help even more at-risk youth enter the workforce with the skills they need to be reliable employees.

This project creates an entrepreneurial experience for youth to learn business management, organizing and operating skills. Students will be required to complete the application and interview process. In addition, they will experience the creation of a small business, including money management, supply, marketing, menu development, pricing, customer service, scheduling, and health and safety standards. Students will also develop leadership skills needed to run a successful enterprise. This will be a youth-run, adult-supervised business. The program offers youth a chance to prepare for the future with life and job skills training. Every young person, regardless of their background, deserves to work towards a brighter future and reach their full potential. WellHouse Pizza will help young people develop the work ethic and skills needed to ensure they thrive.

WellHouse Pizza will partner with Fork Real during its launch period to access employee training on choosing the menu, food preparation, customer service, and scheduling the trailer. The trailer will be open during the summer of 2024.



Meet our New Board Members



Jennifer Kirby

Jennifer Kirby brings personal foster care experience to the Abbott House Board of Directors. Jennifer was born and raised in Sioux Falls, even earning her degree in economics from Augustana University. She went on to earn her Master's in Business Administration at the University of Chicago's Booth School of Business.

After marrying her husband, Joe Kirby, Jennifer moved to California where she and Joe raised three beautiful girls. While California was sunny and warm, Jennifer and Joe both knew that it couldn't compare to the community they knew in Sioux Falls. The pair moved back to Sioux Falls in 2011, and Jennifer began building connections in the community immediately. Since then, Jennifer has

assisted with Sioux Falls projects such as Levitt at the Falls, the Kirby Place, Avera's Light the Way campaign, and the Kirby Dog Park. Currently, Jennifer is on the Avera McKennan Board of Trustees, The Hope Coalition, and serves as Chair of the Sioux Falls Parks Foundation.

Jennifer is familiar with the stories many of our foster children have -- she and Joe adopted two of their children. "I wanted to serve on the Abbott House Board because I've learned through our daughters what life is like for foster kids and how much support they deserve and need," Jennifer explained, "I want to do my part to help them and the best way I can do this is through board service and financial support."

Josey Blare

Josey Blare started her first term on the Abbott House Board this year and is eager to share her skills and knowledge to push Abbott House to be the best it can be. Josey grew up on a farm and ranch northwest of Winner, South Dakota. She went on to earn her BA in International Studies and Native American Studies from the University of South Dakota. During her time in college, Josey assisted with research on the Lakota language and interned at the Bureau of Indian Affairs in Billings, Montana.

After graduation, Josey spent her summer as a participant in the Native American Political Leadership Program through George Washington University, where she had the opportunity to intern with United States Senator Catherine Cortez-Masto of Nevada. Following this unique experience, Josey earned a degree at the University of South Dakota

Knudson School of Law.

Currently, Josey serves as a panel attorney under the Criminal Justice Act. This is where she learned that while she had a fortunate upbringing, others in the Sioux Falls area did not, and that had lasting impacts on their lives. "A former client was the same age as me," Josey shared with us, "and they came from the same community I had. But they had a different childhood, and as a result, we had completely different experiences up to that point and would have entirely different opportunities in our lives going forward."

This was one of the main motivators behind Josey joining the Abbott House Board. "I cannot help but think how different their life could have been if something changed in their childhood," Josey continued, "Abbott House can, and does, truly change lives, and it would be my honor to be apart of it."





Jan Quenzer

Jan Quenzer, a long-time advocate and supporter of Abbott House, has decided to take her passion for helping children even further by joining the Abbott House Board of Directors. Jan has a large heart for South Dakota communities and has spent time volunteering for different causes to make them stronger. Previously, she has been involved in several non-profits, including being the past chair of the Life Quest Foundation. Currently, Jan serves as Chair of the Avera Philanthropy Committee.

Jan spent most of her working career at Mitchell Technical College in Mitchell, SD. There, she worked in the office and saw thousands of young adults both struggle and succeed in school. Jan wanted to support the youth who

Jan now enjoys spending her days gardening and making memories with her six granddaughters.
